

How to Get to the UT



* The following description explains how to get to the University from Kansai International Airport (KIX) in Osaka Prefecture, Japan.

1. Take a direct Express Bus at Bus Terminal No.2
Map and time table are available in the airport homepage.

2. Buy a Ticket and Get on the Bus
To save money, please buy a return bus ticket (7,400 yen).
3. Get off at JR Tokushima station and follow the staff to the hotel to check in.
Please check in at the hotel on August 1, 2014.

* On the first day of the program, our staff members will take you to the campus.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Contact the International Office of YOUR university and get an application form. (Not Available Online)
 2. Fill out the form and submit it to the International Office of YOUR university before the deadline they set.
- * Please submit your passport sized photo with the application form at the International Office of YOUR university.
 - * If the number of applicants exceeds 50, we will select candidates from those nominated by the International Office of your university.
 - * After we finish the selection, we will issue a Letter of Admission for each candidate. If you need to apply for a visa to enter Japan, please apply for it on your own.

- * A program brochure will be sent to each participant with the Letter of Admission. Please take a look at the brochure before you start your preparation.
- * Please be sure to apply through the International Office of your University.

Scholarship & Fees

Registration fee, tuition, official party fees and hotel fees are covered by Governmental Scholarship.

The Scholarship covers most of the expenses you need to pay for this program. Other expenses, including round-trip air fees, transportation fees in and out of Japan, travel insurance*, foods & drinks, shall be covered by the participants.

- * All attendants are required to have a travel/health insurance before entering Tokushima. The insurance should be valid in Japan during their stay for this program.

Who is Eligible?

Undergraduate students (1) who are learning at a UT partner university (or at the university we specially assigned) as a full-time matriculated student and (2) proficient enough to understand lectures in English are eligible for this summer program.

- * Students who have never learned Japanese can also apply if they have sufficient command of English.
- * As shown in APPLICATION PROCEDURE, we select candidates in case the number of total applicants exceeds 50.
- * Graduate students are not eligible for this program.

Credits & Certificate

- * Academic credits from UT are not available for this summer program.
- * After completion of this summer program, we will issue an official Certificate of Completion under the name of the Director of the Center.
